

- Cardboard works as a shelter for snails
- High moisture and no direct sun light
- Trap attracts more snails in fields where the natural shelters are scarce (i.e. tillage field).



1. Add water on the ground in the same area that will be covered by the cardboard.








2. Cover the wet area with the cardboard.

3. Add water on top of the card board until moist.





4. Use a clod of soil to secure so that the wind will not blow away the cardboard.

5. Check the snails every three days.
